What's the difference between Online and On-Demand Courses?

The V.O.I. Ministry of Education is excited to offer on-demand courses. Not only do we offer courses in-person at local extensions, online courses, and live-streaming courses (via zoom), we are now thrilled to offer, on-demand courses.

On-demand courses are self-paced and self-study courses made up of video lectures, assignments, and quizzes. On-demand courses count as 3-unit VETI elective courses.



Students have access to their on-demand courses 24/7 using an internet-connected computer: desktop, laptop, tablet, or smartphone.

Our online and on-demand courses are quite similar. The main difference is that students can enroll in an on-demand course on any day of the year while students in an online course only enroll during specific enrollment dates, four times a year.

Another difference is that online courses include weekly instructor interaction while on-demand courses are entirely self-paced. The third difference is that **On-demand courses are 30 days in length** while online courses are 8 weeks long.

Difference between V.E.T.I. Online and V.E.T.I. On-demand courses

Both options offer exciting opportunities for students who seek increased flexibility in their learning.

Students in both online and on-demand courses log into their course through [Canvas](#), our easy-to-use course management system (students must first [enroll](#) in an on-demand class at GetVeti.com).

Our on-demand courses consist of 4-8 hours of video lectures, reading & writing assignments, and quizzes. **Students have access to our on-demand courses for 30-days. All assignments must be completed during that time. The first day of the course begins on the day of enrollment. Homework for on-demand courses is due on the last day of class.**

On-demand courses are open for enrollment every day, 24/7. Enroll [now](#). Students can enroll in as many courses as they can handle. All of our on-demand courses are available worldwide.

If a person is not interested in receiving a grade or credit for a course he or she can enroll as an [AUDIT student](#) (tuition is \$70 and varies by country).

At this time there are five on-demand courses available, see below. Additional courses will be added soon.

2. Cross-Cultural Evangelism (3 unit elective course)
3. Pioneering a Church (3 unit elective course)

On-demand courses are flexible in that they allow students to balance work, ministry, and home life while pursuing a valuable Christian education.
