Four Learning Formats


At VETI we understand that people learn differently. That's why we offer courses in four different formats:

How to Begin

In order to enroll in a VETI course, you will need to <u>create a</u> <u>student account</u> by completing an application on our student enrollment system, Maestro.

Even if you already have a Victory Outreach account for your past courses, you still need to create a new account on Maestro for all of your future VETI courses.

If you already created an account on Maestro and forgot your password, click on the forgot password button.

Maestro provides you with one location to do all of the following:

- Register and pay for courses (on-site, on-line, on-demand, and streaming live via zoom)
- Access your grades in current courses and monitor your progress
- Log in to your Canvas online and on-demand courses
- Receive updates from the Ministry of Education
- View announcements from your instructors
- Contact your instructors

Having every student apply through Maestro allows Academic Services to obtain the most up-to-date information possible, and avoid duplicate accounts.

Once you have applied, your application will be reviewed and approved within 1 business day.

Once approved you will be notified via the email address used in the application process, with instructions on <u>how to enroll</u> and pay for your VETI, VOBC, Third Wave Campus, or Arguinzoni Academy course.

Keep in mind that each student must have a unique email address. You cannot use the same email address as your spouse or anyone else. Be sure to write your username and password in a safe place so you can easily access them (consider saving your new password in a new contact on your phone).

What to Enroll in First?

There is no specific order in which you are required to enroll in courses although one of your first 3 courses should be "Research, and Writing". This class will teach you how to more easily complete your homework successfully (especially the writing assignments).

If you have already enrolled in an English course at another college or university you do not need to enroll in this course. After a review of the college or university transcripts, we may be able to give you credit for that course.

To check and see what classes you have enrolled in, simply log into <u>Maestro</u> and scroll to the bottom of the page.

If you enrolled in an Online or <u>On-demand course</u>. Here is <u>how to access your course</u>.

Tuition

In the USA the tuition cost for each 3-unit course is \$145.

Transcripts

To see what courses you have previously completed request a copy of your <u>transcripts</u>. Courses from the Modules, VOSOM, VOIBI, etc. still count as VETI elective courses.

What it Takes to Graduate

In order to graduate from VETI, 19 core courses and any 5 elective courses are required. Download the <u>Master Course</u> <u>Checklist</u> to view all of the courses and to keep track. All <u>Arguinzoni Academy</u> courses, Media intensives, Third Wave Training, and past "Modules" count toward the VETI elective requirements. Five elective courses are required to graduate.

Students can access grades/transcripts anytime by logging into their school account, here's how.

Victory Outreach Bible College (VOBC)

For those who desire to continue their education after graduating from VETI, we encourage them to take the "Next Step" and enroll in <u>Victory Outreach Bible College</u> (VOBC) to earn a BA in Christian Ministry.

VOBC is the next step for VETI graduates. VETI graduates can also transfer to any of our <u>partner universities</u> to earn an accredited bachelor's or master's degree.

Whatever your goals are, we believe that VETI is the starting point for all leaders and those seeking to grow in their knowledge of the Bible, doctrine and theology.

The Arguinzoni Academy

The Arguinzoni Academy provides **students** with a variety of practical ministry training from the unique perspective of VOI.

Four Specialty Ministry Tracks are available: Pastoral, Missionary, Evangelistic, and Administrative. Each track is specially designed to equip students with practical tools needed to be effective in the selected concentration.

At the Arguinzoni Academy you can:

- Learn inner-city ministry from the unique perspective of Victory Outreach.
- Receive teaching directly from Pastor Sonny Arguinzoni Sr., the founder of Victory Outreach
- **Connect** with VOI Elders, Regional & Multi-Regional Pastors through quarterly online coaching sessions.
- Earn a certificate in Pastoral, Evangelistic, Missionary or Administrative Ministry.
- Position yourself to be launched out to the mission field.
- Complete any Ministry Track in 1 year. Click here to begin.

There are no requirements needed to enroll in any track. Students can enroll in both VETI and the Arguinzoni Academy at the same time. All Arguinzoni Academy credits received count towards the five required VETI elective courses.
